The purpose of discussion section is to provide students with the opportunity to discuss and evaluate the material from the lectures and from the assigned books. These small-group meetings are your chance to talk about and analyze new concepts as well as to ask questions about the material. A major part of each week's discussion will involve the assigned reading--it is very important that you do the reading before coming to the section meeting on Friday. To help you in your reading, I will provide you with a set of questions about each book. Read these questions first and use them as a guide for the reading; they are meant to help you focus on some of the important themes and concepts in each book. At times there may be a quiz in class--a writing assignment based on the weekly reading that will be drawn from these questions.

Your grade in this section is 20% of your course grade. This section grade will be determined by class participation, performance on quizzes and written assignments, and attendance. Two absences will result in a drop of one point from your section grade (i.e., from A to B or from B to C).
