

## **UW LEND Training Program Requirements**

- Attend UW LEND Program Orientation
- Complete UW LEND Trainee Registration
- Maintain your UW LEND ePortfolio on OneDrive
- Participate in UW LEND Interdisciplinary Clinics or other Interdisciplinary Clinic approved by your discipline leader:
  - Approximately 150-200 hours for In-Residence Trainees
  - Minimum of 50 hours for Community/Distance Trainees
- Participate in-person in MCH Leadership Workshops (1<sup>st</sup> Monday of each month, 12:30pm-3pm)
- Participate in-person or via ZOOM in weekly UW LEND Seminars, (Mondays, 12:30pm-1:30pm)
- Participate in assigned Advocacy/Policy activities
- Visit/Participate in Community-Based/Off-Site activities including:
  - Clinical experiences
  - Leadership experiences
- Meet at least quarterly with assigned UW LEND mentor
- Complete the UW LEND Individual Leadership Training Plan (ILTP)
- Complete and present a Leadership Project
- Complete online Trainee Exit Form
- Complete Exit Interview with Training Director
- Agree to respond to annual web-based follow-up survey at 2 years, 5 years, and 10 years post-training
