



ACADEMIC PATHOLOGISTS ARKANSAS CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) seeks candidates for 3 pathology positions at Arkansas Children's Hospital (ACH). Anatomic pathology will be the focus of two positions, while clinical pathology will be the focus of the third. It is anticipated that one of the anatomic pathology positions will be filled by a junior faculty member at the Assistant Professor level. The other position will be filled by an experienced pathologist who will provide leadership for the surgical pathology division. A clinical pathologist with special expertise in laboratory hematology/coagulation and/or transfusion medicine is preferred.

Arkansas Children's Hospital is a 316-bed, multispecialty, free-standing pediatric hospital located in Little Rock, AR and is one of Fortune magazine's 2008 "100 Best Companies to Work for." The pathology department supports the clinical activities of the hospital by processing over 5,000 in-house cases each year and providing comprehensive laboratory services in all areas of clinical pathology.

Candidates for these positions must be board eligible or board certified in anatomic and/or clinical pathology, as appropriate. Special preference will be given to individuals with specialty training in pediatric pathology. Academic rank, track and salary will be commensurate with qualifications. ACH currently supports seven full-time pathologists and two Ph.D.s. Faculty staffing is by contract with UAMS.
