The Department of Laboratory Medicine at the Yale University School of Medicine seeks an Assistant Professor for a three-quarter time clinical and anatomic pathology position at the affiliated VA Connecticut Healthcare System. Major responsibilities will be in two areas: clinical chemistry and hematopathology. Major responsibilities include being Director of the Clinical Chemistry Laboratory, Assistant Director of Hematology, signout of all lymph node, bone marrow, coagulation, hemoglobinopathy and other hematopathology testing, and rotation on clinical pathology coverage for all other subspecialty laboratory medicine sections. The successful applicant is expected to develop a scholarly program, preferably in the areas of biomedical engineering and translational research, and contribute to medical student, resident, and fellow teaching. Candidates must possess an M.D. and be BE/BC in anatomic and clinical pathology, and in hematopathology.
