

Pediatric Blood Bank/Hematology

The Washington University Department of Pediatrics is seeking a faculty member to assume responsibilities as the Medical Director of the blood bank and the hematology/coagulation laboratories at St. Louis Children's Hospital. The Director would have a faculty appointment within the Division of Laboratory Medicine in the Department of Pediatrics and could be co-appointed in the Division of Pediatric Hematology or the Department of Pathology depending on qualifications and interest. Candidates should be BC/BE in clinical pathology, hematology/oncology, or transfusion medicine. The appointment could be at the Instructor, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor level on either the Clinician or Investigator (tenure) tracks depending upon qualifications. St. Louis Children's Hospital is the tertiary level referral hospital of the Washington University Medical Center and the BJC system. Activities requiring intensive blood bank support include an active and growing stem cell program, comprehensive solid organ transplant programs, a 72 bed NICU, a level I trauma program, and a large sickle cell program. The position will include close interactions with the transfusion medicine program at Barnes-Jewish Hospital. Opportunities exist for developing a program in pediatric transfusion medicine and/or developing a research program in a related area of the dynamic research environment of Washington University.
