<b>Category A</b> <i>(Asymptomatic HIV)</i>	Asymptomatic HIV Infection Persistent generalized lymphadenopathy (PGL) Acute HIV Infection with accompanying illness or hx of HIV infection	
<b>Category B</b> <i>(Symptomatic HIV)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Bacillary angiomatosis</li> <li>▪ Candidiasis, oropharyngeal (thrush), vulvovaginal(&gt;1month)</li> <li>▪ Cervical dysplasia</li> <li>▪ Constitutional symptoms (fever &gt;38 C or diarrhea &gt;1 month)</li> <li>▪ Hairy Leukoplakia</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Herpes zoster (shingles) involving at least 2 distinct episodes or more than 1 dermatome</li> <li>▪ Idiopathic thrombocytopenia purpura</li> <li>▪ Listeriosis</li> <li>▪ Pelvic Inflammatory Disease</li> <li>▪ Peripheral Neuropathy</li> </ul>
<b>Category C</b> <i>(AIDS Defining Infections)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Candidiasis of bronchi, trachea, or lungs</li> <li>▪ Candidiasis, esophageal</li> <li>▪ Cervical cancer, invasive</li> <li>▪ Coccidioidomycosis, disseminated or extrapulmonary</li> <li>▪ Cryptococcosis, extrapulmonary</li> <li>▪ Cryptosporidiosis, chronic (&gt;1 month)</li> <li>▪ Cytomegalovirus disease or retinitis</li> <li>▪ Encephalopathy, HIV related</li> <li>▪ Herpes simplex virus (HSV)</li> <li>▪ Histoplasmosis, disseminated or extrapulmonary</li> <li>▪ HIV-associated dementia</li> <li>▪ Isosporiasis, chronic intestinal (&gt;1 month)</li> <li>▪ Kaposi sarcoma</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Lymphoid interstitial pneumonia</li> <li>▪ Lymphoma, Burkitt's, immunoblastic, primary of brain</li> <li>▪ <i>Mycobacterium avium-intracellulare</i> complex (MAC)</li> <li>▪ <i>Mycobacterium tuberculosis, pulmonary or extrapulmonary</i></li> <li>▪ Nocardiosis</li> <li>▪ <i>Pneumocystis carinii</i> pneumonia</li> <li>▪ Pneumonia, recurrent</li> <li>▪ Progressive multifocal leukoencephalopathy (PML)</li> <li>▪ <i>Salmonella</i> septicemia, recurrent</li> <li>▪ Toxoplasmosis of internal organs</li> <li>▪ Wasting syndrome due to HIV</li> </ul>
