

- I. **Line up (12:00 p.m.):** Go through the faculty security check-in at the Dempsey Indoor Practice Facility northeast of the stadium. Pick up your gold baton at the commencement table as you enter Dempsey. (After the ceremony, commencement personnel will meet you at the back of the seating area on the Husky stadium field, as you are recessing, to take your baton.) At Dempsey you will assist Norm Arkans in the assembly of the candidates.
- II. **Procession:** At 1:20 p.m. (just prior to the procession) take position #3 (see chart). Norm Arkans will control the entrance of the various groups on the north. Encourage students to remain in their lines. If you notice anything that might require slowing down the entrance of the various groups of candidates, notify Norm.
- III. When all the bachelor candidates have entered the stadium, move to a position next to (north of) marshal #6 (see chart). Once the Deans' and President's parties have gone to the stage, the Seating and Westend marshals will come up as a group. Fall in behind them and go to your stage seat (via the *south* ramp).
- IV. **Master's & Bachelor March to the Stage:** Go to position F on the stage (see diagram). Direct the students toward the correct ramps as they leave the stage. Master's and Bachelor candidates follow both the red and blue lines shown on your diagram. The Chief Marshal and the other Assistant Chief Marshal will split this duty with you during the Bachelor March.
- V. **Recession:** During the recession you will exit with the faculty group. The Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal #4 have additional duties during the recessional. You do not. Therefore, you may simply exit with the faculty group and proceed to the west end of the stadium. From there you may disperse with the rest of the faculty or exit via the tunnel to the faculty dressing room.
