

Chief Marshal #5

- I. **Line up (12:00 p.m.):** Go through the faculty security check-in at the Dempsey Indoor Practice Facility northeast of the stadium. Pick up your velvet baton at the commencement table as you enter Dempsey. (After the ceremony, commencement personnel will meet you at the back of the seating area on the Husky stadium field, as you are recessing, to take your baton.) At Dempsey you will assist the NE Lining up Marshal and the Faculty Marshals in the assembly of the candidates and the line-up of the faculty procession.
- II. **Procession:** At 1:20 p.m. (just prior to the procession) take position #5 (see chart). During the procession you will help direct faculty to the stage. Direct the Deans' Party toward marshal #9 and the President's Party to Marshal #8. After the President's and Deans' parties have gone to the stage, the Seating and Westend marshals will come forward to the stage. Follow them up the south ramp to your stage seat.
- III. **Doctoral & Bachelor March to the Stage:** Go to position F on the stage (see diagram). Direct the students to the correct ramps as they leave the stage. Doctoral candidates follow the blue lines shown on your diagram. Bachelor candidates follow both the red and blue lines. The two Assistant Chief Marshals will split this duty with you during the Bachelor March. You may also ask Assistant Chief Marshal #4 to split this duty with you during the doctoral march to the stage.
- IV. **Recession:** Follow the Grand Marshals off the stage (after the Deans' party). Stop at position N. Ask students to remain in their seats and not block the center aisle until all the stage occupants (and the marshals at the bottom of the ramps) have passed. Fall in behind the stage party and marshals and proceed up the aisle to the west end of the stadium. From there you may disperse with the rest of the faculty or exit via the tunnel to the faculty dressing room.
