- I. **Check-in:** Please check in at the Touchdown Terrace. (Brunch will run from 11:00 am 12:30 pm.)
- II. Procession 1:30 pm.: Stanchioning of all lines begins at the top of the ramp to the field, at the NE corner of Touchdown Terrace.

At 1:15, go to your position. You will work with your team to channel the students – in approximately equal numbers - into the four stanchioned lines.

The grand marshal arrives first and should be directed into line 3. Direct faculty who follow into the two middle lines (34 & 36 on diagram). Doctoral candidates follow in four lines. Try to ensure equal numbers enter each stanchioned line.

Bachelor candidates follow in 5 groups of about 500 students, each group is led by a gonfaloniere. Again, our goal is to have approximately even numbers of students in each line. Students who want to sit together should be in the same line.

After the candidates have been seated, the Deans Party, then the President's Party, will process to the stage. As soon as the entire President's Party is on stage, walk up the outside ramp to your stage see (see diagram).

- III. **Doctoral and Master's marches to the stage:** You may remain seated on stage during these marches.
- IV. **Bachelor march to the stage (see diagram):** When bachelor candidates are asked to come forward, go to position "t." Ensure that bachelor candidates returning from the stage remain in the center aisle and walk all the way to the back of the seating section, unless a seating marshal directs otherwise. Students should not cut through your corridor to their seats. After all the students have passed, remain at "t." It becomes position "**DD**" for the recessional.
- V. Recessional (see diagram): At position "DD," (same as "t") encourage students to remain in their seats until the stage party has cleared the center aisle. Students may leave the seating area when the classical music ends and the pop music begins. You may then disperse with the rest of the faculty.
