Guidelines for Capstone Posters

Size: 30 inches wide by 20 inches tall.

Heading: title of your project, and your name and affiliations.

Your poster should have the following **sections**:

- *MCH Concern:* Introduce the concern or problem in terms of scope, severity, or trend.
- *Approach:* Describe the data source you've identified to address the concern and your methods.
- *Findings:* Provide results and include at least 1 figure/table.
- *Implications:* Describe implications for MCH policy or services in the U.S.
