What We Do

Conduct street and communitybased outreach & provide basic first aid and resource navigation to homeless individuals in Seattle's University District

Train UW Health Sciences students in providing compassionate care to homeless individuals

Collaborate with current and formerly homeless individuals and community service providers to design accountable service provision



Our Impact July 2015-March 2016

- 270 individual patient encounters
- 109 unique referrals to services including dental, medical and housing needs
- 54 basic wellness checks (blood pressure readings, glucose readings)
- Over 1,000 outreach supplies distributed

- Established practicum opportunities for Master of Social Work & Master of Public Health students
