UNDERGRADUATE FUNDING

Astronaut Scholarship Foundation

Created to ensure the US maintains its leadership in science and technology by supporting promising students in STEM fields. *Campus Deadline: Jan.*

Boren Undergraduate Scholarship

Study abroad funding to study languages and experience areas of the world critical to US national security. *Campus Deadline: Jan.*

Critical Language Scholarships

Provide fully-funded group-based intensive language instruction and structured cultural enrichment experiences for seven to ten weeks for U.S. citizen undergraduate, Master's and Ph.D. students. *Deadline: Nov.*

DAAD - RISE, Undergraduate Scholarship

A summer research program in Germany for undergraduate students enrolled at a university in the US, Canada and the UK in the fields of biology, chemistry, physics, earth sciences and engineering. *Deadline: Jan.*

Department of Defense SMART Scholarship for Service

Supports undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees and research in STEM disciplines. *Deadline: Dec.*

Fulbright UK Summer Institutes

Provide the opportunity for US undergrads with at least 2 years of undergraduate study left to complete, to go to the UK on a fully-funded three, four, five or six week academic and cultural summer program. *Deadline: Feb-Mar.*

Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program

Provides awards of up to \$5,000 for U.S. undergraduate students with financial need to study abroad for up to one academic year. *Deadlines: Oct. & Mar.*

Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship

Up to \$15,000 for undergraduates engaging in research to prepare for research careers in engineering, math, and the natural sciences. *Campus Deadline: Nov. of Soph. or Jr. years.*

Humanity In Action

Intensive and demanding, the Humanity in Action Fellowship brings together international groups of students and recent graduates to explore national histories of discrimination and resistance, as well as examples of issues affecting different minority groups today. *Deadline: Jan.*

National Geographic Young Explorers Grants

Up to \$5,000 to help cover field project costs for research projects, conservation efforts, or expeditions that fit within National Geographic's fields of interest. *Deadline: rolling.*

National Institutes of Health (NIH) Undergraduate Scholarship

Up to \$20,000/year for up to 4 years for students from disadvantaged backgrounds who are committed to careers in biomedical, behavioral, and social science health-related research. *Deadline: Feb.*

NOAA Hollings Undergraduate Scholarship

Designed to increase undergraduate training in oceanic and atmospheric science, research, technology, and education and foster multidisciplinary training opportunities. Provides \$8,000/year for 2 years & summer internships. *Deadline: Jan. of Soph. year.*

Thomas R. Pickering Undergraduate Foreign Affairs Fellowship

Provides financial support, mentoring and professional development to prepare students academically and professionally for a career in the U.S. Department of State Foreign Service. *Deadline: Feb. of Jr. year.*

Public Policy & International Affairs Program (PPIA)

Provides student training and financial support for graduate school and facilitates ongoing professional development in public and international affairs. *Deadline: Nov. of Jr. year.*

\$7,000 scholarship awarded to sophomores and juniors planning to pursue careers in environmental policy OR Native health care or tribal policy. *Campus Deadline: Dec.*

Elie Wiesel Prize for Humanity

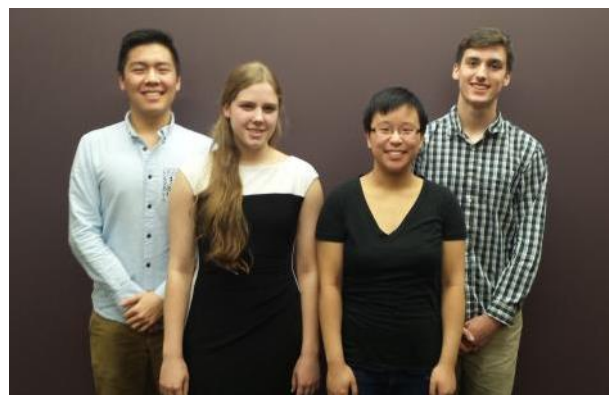
Contest awarding \$5,000 to a college junior or senior for the best essay on a topic related to ethics. *Deadline: Dec.*

YMA Fashion Scholarship Fund

A national not-for-profit association consisting of influential members of the fashion community, dedicated to promoting education of the fashion arts and business by granting scholarships to talented students and facilitating internships, mentorships and career programs. *Deadline: Oct.*

Tillman Military Scholars Program

The Pat Tillman Foundation is a national leader in providing resources and educational scholarship support to veterans, active service members and their spouses. *Deadline: Mar.*

POST-BACCALAUREATE FUNDING

Carnegie Endowment Jr. Fellowship

Work as a research assistant to the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace's senior associates, researching issues of international significance. *Campus Deadline: Dec. of Sr. year or within one year of graduation.*

DAAD Graduate Study/Research

Awarded to highly qualified graduating seniors or those who have received an undergraduate degree in all disciplines for a year of independent research or a full master's degree program at a German university. *Campus Deadline: Oct.*

Fulbright US Student Program

For research, graduate study, or teaching English abroad in one of over 160 countries. *Campus Deadline: Sept. of Sr. year or subsequent years.*

Luce Scholars Program

Provides stipends, language training and Individualized professional placement in Asia each year for college seniors, graduate students and young professionals who have limited exposure to Asia. *Campus Deadline: Sept.*

Samuel Huntington Public Service Award

Annual stipend of \$15,000 awarded to graduating seniors to engage in meaningful public service for up to one year anywhere in the world. *Deadline: Jan. of Sr. year.*

NIH Post-Baccalaureate Intramural Research Training Award

Provides opportunities for recent college graduates to spend a year engaged in biomedical research at the NIH. *Deadline: rolling.*

GRADUATE FUNDING

Beinecke Scholarship

\$34,000 for the first two years of graduate study in the arts, humanities, and the social sciences. *Campus Deadline: Jan. of Jr. year.*

Boren Graduate Fellowship

Study abroad funding to study languages and experience areas of the world critical to US national security. *Campus Deadline: Jan.*

Winston Churchill Scholarship

Study engineering, mathematics, or natural science at Churchill College, Cambridge University, England for one year. *Campus Deadline: Apr.*

Department of Defense SMART Scholarship for Service

Supports undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees and research in STEM disciplines. *Deadline: Dec.*

Fulbright US Student Program

For research, graduate study, or teaching English abroad in one of over 160 countries. *Campus Deadline: Sept. of Sr. year or subsequent years.*

Gates Cambridge Scholarship

For graduate study at the University of Cambridge. *Campus Deadline: Apr.*

Hertz Foundation Graduate Fellowship

For graduate work leading to a Ph.D. degree in physical, biological and engineering science. *Deadline: Oct.*

Kate Neal Kinley Scholarship

Opportunity to enhance students' professional status, to aid their pursuit of an advanced degree, or to finance a special project in the fine and applied arts. *Deadline: Jan.*

Knowles Science Teaching Foundation Fellowship (KSTF)

Provides professional and financial support to those who have received a Bachelor's or advanced degree in science, engineering or mathematics and are committed to teaching high school science and/or mathematics in U.S. schools. *Deadline: Jan.*

James Madison Junior Fellowship

Fellowships for future and current secondary school teachers of American history, American government, and social studies. *Deadline: Mar.*

Marshall Scholarship

Three years of study in any discipline at any university in the United Kingdom. *Campus Deadline: Apr.*

George J. Mitchell Scholarship

Full support for up to three years of graduate study or research at seven universities in the Republic of Ireland and the two universities in Northern Ireland. *Campus Deadline: Apr.*

National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate Fellowship

Tuition, fees, and a yearly stipend of \$24,000 for three years for graduate study in science and engineering. *Deadline: Jan.*

National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship

Graduate study leading to research-based master's or doctoral degrees in the mathematical, physical, biological, behavioral and social sciences, and engineering. *Deadline: Oct.*

Thomas R. Pickering Graduate Foreign Affairs Fellowship

Funds graduate study in public policy, international affairs, public administration, business, economics, political science, sociology or foreign languages, or other fields, for those who intend to become Foreign Service Officers. *Deadline: Feb.*

Charles B. Rangel International Affairs Fellowship

For completion of a two-year master's degree such as public administration, public policy, business administration, foreign languages, economics, political science, communications. For those who intend to become Foreign Service Officers. *Deadline: Sept.*

Rhodes Scholarship

For two years of study at Oxford University, England. *Campus Deadline: Apr.*

Schwarzman Scholars Program

Funds a 1-year master's program at Tsinghua University in Beijing. *Deadline: Sept.*

Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowship for New Americans

Up to \$90,000 in funding for New Americans--Immigrants and children of immigrants--who are pursuing graduate school in the US. *Deadline: Nov.*

Tillman Military Scholars Program

The Pat Tillman Foundation is a national leader in providing resources and educational scholarship support to veterans, active service members and their spouses. *Deadline: Mar.*

Harry S. Truman Scholarship

\$30,000 scholarship awarded to college juniors who are preparing for careers in public service; funds up to three years of graduate school. *Campus Deadline: Nov. of Jr. year.*

Yenching Academy

An intensive, funded 1-year Master's program of interdisciplinary classroom and field study of Chinese history, culture, and real-time issues in China's development at Peking University. *Campus Deadline: Dec.*
