

**Peace for the Streets by Kids from the Streets (PSKS)** is open 365 nights a year and serves 20 young adults, ages 18-29, each night. We are fighting to end homelessness in Seattle and need your support. *This shift starts at 9:00 pm and ends at 8:30 am the following morning.* We ask volunteers to commit to one night a week. Volunteers may work a 12- hour shift or a 3-hour shift (9pm – 12 midnight).

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Engage with guests while setting up the shelter.
- Complete intake paperwork for new guests and distributing hygiene supplies.
- Serve dinner and clean up our kitchen.

All volunteers are supported by two (2) Overnight Shelter Staff and a Program Manager, in case there are any questions or concerns during your shift.

### **Requirements & Commitment**

- Background Check
- Must be at least 18
- Volunteer orientation and training
- Commit to at least 3 to 6 months

### **Benefits**

- Gain social service experience, earn college credit for service learning and/or practicum hours, and serve the community all at the same time!
- Periods of downtime throughout the evening to work on class assignments, projects and more!
