

CAREGIVER FOR YOUNG DISABLED ADULT WOMAN

POSITION SUMMARY

We are currently seeking a Caregiver to join our team providing care for our 22-year old daughter with intellectual disabilities. This is a live-in Caregiving position, with the role providing care on weekdays from 4:00pm to 7:00am, and on weekends from 8:00pm to 7:00am. Care will take place in modern, spacious home located in the Wedgwood neighborhood in northeast Seattle.

The home will house only our disabled daughter and one caregiver. Our daughter has been living in the home for the past 18 months and is fully acclimated to living away from her parent's home. She is very social, active, enjoys seeing other people, going out in the community. She is physically independent needs only light direction on personal care with dressing and bathing. No lifting or equipment required. She needs assistance navigating her afternoon and early evening, evening, making good choices, etc. She sleeps well at night so there is typically no night-time care/interaction required between 8:00pm and 7:00am.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide personal care support to our daughter, following direction provided by service plans and behavior plans that have been tailored to her needs.
- Provide supervision, which may include companionship, emotional support, regular conversations, problem-solving, and suggestions on occupying activities.
- Perform evening meal planning and meal preparation for daughter and self
- Provide occasional transportation for our daughter to attend work and social activities.
- Communicate and coordinate with us (her parents/guardians) to understand care/supervisory requirements of our daughter, make status reports, report behavioral incidents, and seek input/guidance.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Certified Home Care Aide (HCA), Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), or Nursing (LPN/RN) OR willing to become certified as an HCA (Home Care Aide) within 200 days of hire employment (training time is paid)
- Fluency in English
- CPR/First Aid certification (can be secured with 90 days post-hire)
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- No previous criminal history
- Excellent work and personal references
- Washington State ID or Washington State Driver's License
- Must be eligible to work in the U.S.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- You will be working and living in a beautiful 5-bedroom, residential home in the Wedgwood neighborhood in northeast Seattle. The home was recently renovated, has ample common and private areas, and has modern appliances and finishes throughout.
