To support and honor female graduate students of medicine, law or social and public services. This scholarship is available to students who have completed at least one year of graduate work.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Open female to students in Graduate or Professional degree programs in the state of Washington.
- Support for advanced degrees at public 4-year colleges or universities.
- Open to Education, Law, Health, Science & Engineering, and Public affairs students.
- Must demonstrate financial need, number of family members in household, number of family dependents attending college, family income.

APPLICATION COMPONENTS

To apply please register and create an account on the WashBoard: https://washboard.wsac.wa.gov/login.aspx

Key application components include:

- **Essay:** Write an essay (up to 500 words) telling us about yourself, your educational achievements and your future career goals. Discuss the challenges you foresee and how you plan to accomplish your goals.
- Transcript: Please upload a copy of your transcript(s) for every applicable level of education and/or all schools you attended from undergrad through present. An unofficial transcript is acceptable for application. Scholarship recipients will be required to submit an official transcript to The Seattle Foundation by July 15; funds will not be released to your school until we receive it.
- Letters of Recommendation: Two letters of recommendation, one from an individual who can speak to the applicant's academic credentials and one from an individual not directly tied to academic activities. Letters of recommendation may not be from a relative of the applicant.
