One way we do this is by helping families to create personal networks of support (aka a circle of friends) around a focus person. As a Network Facilitator you work as part of a Network Development Team to create and facilitate networks where focus people:

- Experience joy and a sense of belonging to a circle of friends
- Have their strengths and interests appreciated and celebrated
- Are honored and empowered to make decisions
- Are assisted in planning and goal setting
- Experience being part of a larger community, with people looking out for them
