Walter G. Andrews is a professor of Near Eastern Languages and Civilization at the University of Washington. Over a career of more than 40 years, he has published many scholarly studies on Ottoman Turkish poetry and translations from Ottoman and Modern Turkish Literatures. His recent publications include *The Age of Beloveds, Love and The Beloved in Early-Modern Ottoman and European Culture and Society* with Mehmet Kalpaklı (Duke University Press, 2005) and *Hilmi Yavuz, Seasons of the Word, A Selection of Poems* (Syracuse University Press, 2006).

Walter will be interviewed by Dr. Selim S. Kuru, professor of Turkish and Ottoman Literature at the University of Washington.
