Dear Student,

We would like to welcome you to your Obstetrics and Gynecology Basic Clerkship. During this six week clerkship you will have the opportunity to apply and increase your knowledge in both clinical and didactic settings. Our faculty members enjoy teaching, especially in a one-on-one basis. We hope you will take advantage of their expertise and learn as much as possible; do not be afraid to ask questions.

Your orientation will take place in Billings on the first morning at 7:00AM. Please report to the OB/GYN department on the second floor of the Billings Clinic. You should review pelvic anatomy before the orientation, as well as read the web-based Student Course Guide. You will find the web based Course Guide especially useful because it contains a description of the clerkship, course requirements, and an explanation of the evaluation instruments. The Guide also includes the required topics for course reading. It will be to your benefit to be familiar with all the topics listed, either through experience or through reading.

Your rotation schedule will be given to you during orientation at the site. You will need your black bag of instruments for clinic.
