What's planned?

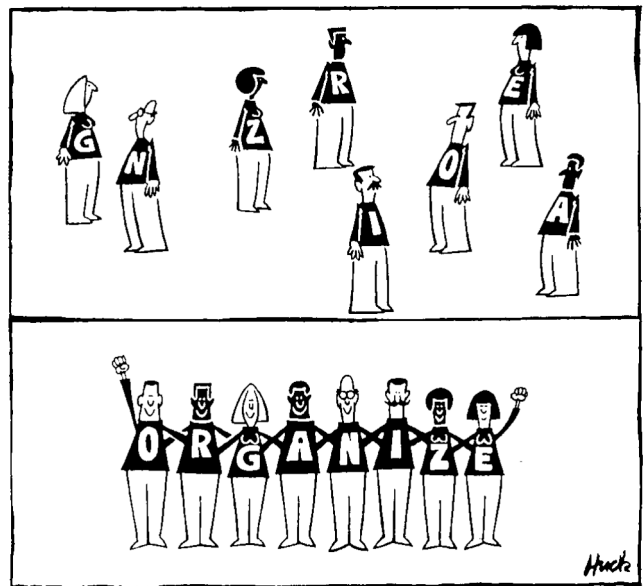
Here is a sample of the sessions in the Section's schedule:
