Submit to the Department of Physiology and Biophysics:

Printout of the web application submitted to the graduate school

The Biomedical Sciences graduate program application (Part of the online application to the Graduate School and doesn't need to be re-filled out if you are applying online.)

A one page discussion of such topics as which areas of research interest you, which faculty members' work is of interest to you, your previous research experience and publications, and your long-term goals.

A CV or resume highlighting your research experience

Four recommendation letters with forms
(MUST BE in a sealed envelope, or can be sent separately)

An official copy of all your college or university transcripts
(MUST BE in a sealed envelope, or can be sent separately)

An unofficial copy of your GRE score report.
(We will get the official score from the Graduate School)

We ONLY offer a PhD and only accept applications for AUTUMN quarter.

If you cannot send official copies of your transcripts right away, please submit unofficial copies in the interim.

We suggest you take the GRE no later than December in order for the official scores to be processed by the Graduate School by the deadline. We can use an unofficial copy of your GRE score report prior to our verification of the score with the Graduate School.
