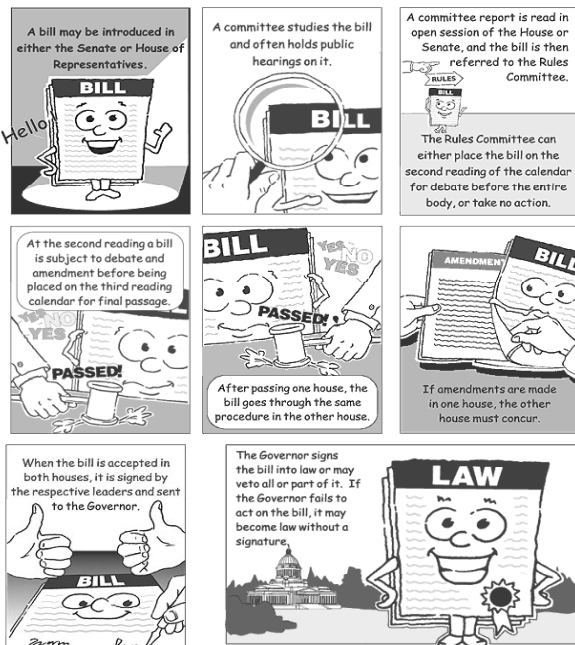

WA Legislature Site

- www.leg.wa.gov
 - search (upper right hand corner)
 - read the instructions when first opening; they go away
 - truncation/multiple word forms – "*" and "word1-word2"
 - Boolean operators (and, not, or)
 - "character string enclosed in quotes"
 - note thing with WAC – have to use "\" to include the hyphen
 - Remember to check all the boxes you want

Search tips & tricks

- Very different from PubMed and other biomedical databases
- Truncation options, e.g., ! instead of *
- Use “Positional Operators” if available when doing full text searches; i.e., w/25
- Natural language vs. controlled vocabulary

Mindset

- Prepare
 - Outline search question
 - Identify synonyms
- Where would I be if ...?

Web Search Engines – Beware

- Exceptionally fast → lots of garbage
- Use Advanced Search functions

- You are responsible for accuracy
 - Site from primary or secondary sources whenever possible
 - Strive for refereed sources; triangulate when opinion, personal communication
