### **Where is the PNC Blog hosted?**

### **Who is responsible?**

### **Who can post?**

Authors need a login (first initial last name in lower case) and password. Access has been set up for PNC Board members and committee chairs. Other would-be authors should contact Kathy Murray.

### **How do I retrieve my lost password?**

Please contact Kathy Murray who can reset this for you.

### **Who can comment on posts?**

Anybody can comment. No password is required. The first time a person submits a comment it is approved /disapproved by the Coordinator. Subsequent posts by this person are not vetted.

### **What kinds of information shall I post?**

Posts should be succinct, and on a single topic related to the fields of health librarianship. Blogs tend to be more conversational than official pronouncements. PNC members also post on HLIB. Our goal is to avoid duplicate information on the two communication venues, so please consider if your message is more suited to the PNC Blog than HLIB. HLIB members receive a teaser and link to the PNC Blog when new PNC Blog posts appear, but not when comments are made.

### **How do I assign a category to my post?**

After you log in, select the Add New link on the left side of the dash board to see the full listing. Authors can add new categories, but please check with Hope before doing so, to keep the listing simple. Tags can also be appended to posts.

### **How busy is the PNC Blog?**

We aim to post often enough to keep things interesting, but not so much that folks get annoyed. At present we are posting once or twice a week.
