Eligibility Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree
- Graduate Record Exam (GRE)
- **Grade Point Requirement:** Applicants must have a cumulative and prerequisite GPA of at least 3.0 (B). No single prerequisite courses can be graded less than 2.0 (C).
- Prerequisites
 - Two-course physics series w/lab and one course in each of the following areas:
 - Life sciences w/lab (e.g. biology, microbiology)
 - Chemistry w/lab
 - General psychology
 - Developmental psychology -or- Abnormal psychology
 - Statistics
 - Human anatomy w/lab*
 - Physiology w/lab*
 - * if your school offers combined A&P courses, you will want to take a twocourse A&P series
 - · Volunteering at a P&O clinic is strongly encouraged
