TSMIN 200 International Interactions has been one of two possible choices (TSMIN 200 or TGH 301) for fulfilling the 5 credit International or Global Interactions Core requirement for the Global Studies concentration for years. Two new world history courses were recently approved. TSMIN 100 World History: Prehistory to 1500 (permanent change from TCXG 230 approved 6/16/09) and TSMIN 101 World History II: 1500-present (permanent new course approved 2/16/10). It is the intent of the IAS history faculty to no longer teach TSMIN 200 and to allow students to fulfill the 5 credit "international" core requirement in Global Studies by successfully completing either TSMIN 100, TSMIN 101, or TGH 301. TSMIN 100 and TSMIN 101 were first offered in 2010, Winter and Spring quarters respectively. We are asking for this 1503 to be effective Winter 2010 so that students may use either course to satisfy the 5 international core credits required by the Global Studies concentration. Note: IAS has proposed new prefixes and numbers for many courses. In the proposed scheme, TSMIN 100 transforms to THIST 150 and TSMIN 101 to THIST 151.
