EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The original 1503 creating this minor in 1995 contained a typo. The minor requirements currently specify HIST 490 as a required course. The minor was intended to require HIST 493, Senior Research in the History of Science. HIST 490 did not exist in 1995 (it was not created until 2002). We seek to correct this typographical error to bring the catalog copy into line with our original intentions and practice. The Degree Audit Reporting System (DARS) which audits student degree progress has had the correct information since the system was created, so this will not impact any students already working toward this minor.


