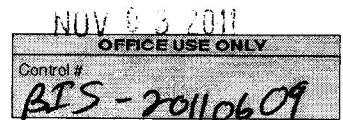

EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

1. In order to develop students' research capacities, and in keeping with a greater emphasis on research in the GST core, the Global Studies Bachelor of Arts will adopt a methods course requirement. Students must take one of the following:

BES 301 Scientific Methods and Practice
BIS 312 Approaches to Social Research
BIS 315 Understanding Statistics
BIS 340 Approaches to Cultural Research
BIS 342 Geographic Information Systems

as part of their major requirements.

Students will then be required to take 30 additional GST courses, either from this list or from the standard GST list. (They are currently required to take 35 credits of GST courses, and that list now includes BIS 312, 315, 340, and 342).

BES 301 is added to reflect and encourage student interest in global environmental issues.

2. BISGST 303 History and Globalization will now be the only GST core course. BISGST 324 International and Political Economy and BISGST 362 Contemporary Political Ideas and Ideologies will no longer satisfy the GST core course requirement.


