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EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The Medical Technology Program (MTP), Bachelor of Science currently requires students to take either MATH 124 or MATH 144 or STAT 220 to meet admission requirements for the major. However, the MTP is accredited by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS) and this agency requires all students to complete a Statistics course. Therefore, we would like to eliminate the Calculus admission requirement option and solely require Statistics to meet the math admission requirements. We would also like to give students the option of choosing from the following Statistics courses to meet this admission requirement:

- STAT 220
- STAT 221 or SOC/CSSS 221
- STAT 311
- QSCI 381

Not applicable because STATS is not a new requirement, we are simply eliminating Calculus as an admission requirement option and solely requiring STATS. Also correcting credits for admission.






