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EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

For new program, please include any relevant supporting documentation such as student learning outcomes, projected enrollments, letters of support and departmental handouts. *(Use additional pages if necessary).*

The proposed changes to admissions requirements are for two primary reasons. First, we propose to drop the requirement that students obtain 40 college-level credits prior to admission into the degree. With the development of UW Tacoma's programs for freshmen and sophomores, this requirement no longer makes sense. Having students enter the major earlier allows them to receive advising for majors, and to be better informed (e.g. through inclusion on email announcement lists) about the many events and job opportunities for our students. The second reason concerns the addition of minimal pre-requisites in mathematics and computer science. If students do not have pre-calculus prior to entering the major, then they will not quality to take any courses in the major. Adding this as an entrance requirement thus makes this requirement explicit to students at the outset. Our programming requirement is proposed because experience has shown us that many entering students do not recognize that Computer Science involves programming—rather than use—of computers. By adding this requirement, students will at least have som conception of this central activity to the major.

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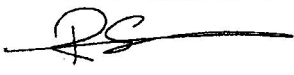

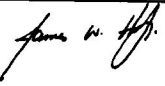
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
