| 2. | achaash tk'i- tk'inxaam imikink achaashki | eyes to see you see with your eyes |
| 3. | im sinwi- tkwata- sinwixaam ku tkwataxa imikink imki | mouth to talk to eat you talk and eat with your mouth |
| 4. | nushnu nukshi- nukshixaam imikink nushnuki | nose to smell you smell with your nose |
| 5. | ipap wapasha- wapashaxaam imikink ipapki | hands to touch you touch with your hands |
