

**SHORT PHRASES IN YAKIMA SHAHAPTIN**  
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VERBS

Tuti	Verb Stem -(to) <u>stand</u>
Tutik !	<u>Stand up!</u> (Command)
Imk nam titita.	<u>You stand up.</u>
Ink nash tutixa.	<u>I (usually) stand.</u>
Mish nam chaw imk titita?	<u>Won't you stand up?</u>
Mish, chaw nam imk tutitat'asha?	<u>Why, don't you want to stand up?</u>
Chaw nash atk'ixsha tutit.	<u>I don't want to stand up.</u>
Namak namtk tutita.	<u>We will stand up.</u> (inclusive term)
Chii (Chuu)	Verb stem- (to) <u>drink</u>
Chiish! (Chuush)	<u>Drink!</u> To drink water before and after a meal.
Aw nash chiisha.	<u>Now I'm drinking water.</u>
Imak aw chiitk.	<u>You folks drink water now.</u>
Atawi-	Verb Stem- (to) <u>love</u> , or <u>to respect</u> , or <u>to honor</u> .
Atawishamash.	<u>I love you.</u>
Mish nam pa'atawisha inak?	<u>Do you love me?</u>
Tiinma nam pa'atawisha imanak..	<u>The people respect you.</u>
Pmak pat awatawisha pinak.	<u>They respect him.</u>
Namak namtk awatawisha pinak.	We <u>all respect(honor ) him.</u> (exclusive term)
Atawita pam tiicham..	<u>Honor your land.</u>
