Ichi iwa inmi ám. (husband)

Ichi iwa inmi ásham. (wife) Compare with ashim.

Ichi iwa inmi k'úsi. (horse)

Ichi iwa inmi t'k'ám. (moccasins)

Ichi iwa inmi pats. (Your younger brother, a woman's word)

Ichi iwa inmi tsníts. (your younger sister, a man's word)

Ichi iwa inmi útpass. (blanket, robe)

Ichi iwa inmi ts'xwili. (tepee)

Ichi iwa inmi kiwkiwlás. (drum)

Ichi iwa inmi ap'úus. (cat)
