VERB FORMS IN YAKIMA SAHAPTIN

The classification of the "Saxaaptin" languages which are located in the northwest states of Idaho, Oregon and Washington was through the similar word inflections in the native language spoken by each tribe. Although, Nez Perce is as different as Italian is from Spanish, there are similarities in structure and phonology.
