Verb intransitive= v.i. Verb transitive = v.t.

- 1. Wash mash plash timash? Do you have white paper? v.i.

 Chaw, wash nash plaash timash. No, I have off-white paper.
- 2. Wash mash mixixsh timat'awaas? Do you have a yellow pencil? v.i.
 Chaw, washnash mixishpyat timat'awaas. No, I have a green pencil.
- 3. Wash mash kuyx k'usi? Do you have a white horse?(animate white) v.i.

 Chaw, wash nash chmuk k'usi. No, I have a black horse.
- 4. Mish mash wa mikił istama kitisma. Do you have orange kittens? v.t.

 Chaw, washnash lampt istmama.

 No, I have purple babies.

 (istama means non-human, [inanimate] baby)
- Mish mash wacha luts'a kapu? Did you have a red coat? v.t.
 Chaw, wachaash plash kapu. No, I had a white coate (inanimate white)

Please emphasise the difference between inanimate and animate nouns and pronouns, present and past tense verbs, and objective nouns and pronouns.
