

Developing and Expanding Sentences

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I A basic sentence consists of
a noun and verb.
The noun tells who is doing
what. The verb is the action
the noun is taking.

A present tense sentence.
(N + V - present tense)

K'usi k'usi i-wah-wak-sha.
The dog is barking

II The basic sentence is expanded by
adding an adjective to describe
the dog.

Chmuk k'usi k'usi i-wah-wak-sha.
The black dog is barking

III Add another adjective to describe
the dog.

Nch'i chmuk k'usi k'usi i-wah-wak-sha.
The big black dog is barking.

① I-wiNA-sha — He is going

② I-wiNA-sha — She is going

* ③ I-wiNA-sha — It is going
