OTHER LINKING VERBS:

Chiyawáw means unworthy, useless.

Chiyawáw iwa iwinsh. The man is no good.

The man is useless.

Chaw ikutkutát'asha. He does not want to work.

Chaw itk'ixsha kutkut. He does not like to work.

Linking: Sxixshaash. I am angry.

Action: Áwiinpaash sxixni. I answered her/him angrily.

Linking: Wapasham, laxuyxshaash. Feel me, I'm hot.

Action: Iwapashanaash twáti nim. The doctor laid his hand upon me to heal me. Don't laugh.

Sentence: Páwapashana twáti'in. The doctor felt her/him.

Do question: Mish pámiya twáti'in? What did the doctor do?

Answer: Páwapashana payúyinan. He felt the sick person.

Sentence: Wapashaia iwacha twáti. The doctor was a Hand-healer.

Do question: Mish imiya twáti. What did the doctor do?

Answer: Iwapashana payúyinan. He healed the sick person.
