











4. *mouth* im imki-na tkwata-xa tkwatat. *We eat food.* *to eat* *Food* 
5. *tradition spelling* i mki-na pishkw'in-xa. *smile* *P'ahkwi* *teeth* 
6. *in our mouth we have* im-pa-na wa Itit, *tongue*

8. *+ + pama* p'uxst-pama im *for*
