1. SHIN MASH WA NAMUN? *who is your relation*
2. IKW'AK NASH WA NAPUSAS KU NA'ALAS. *that is my mother's friend's mother*
3. MISH MIYANASHMA PASHUKWASHA SHIN AWA NAMUN? *my mother's friend's mother's name is what?*
4. PASHUKSHA ALAPA KU PUSHAPA. *possessive singular*
5. SHIN AWA ITUTNMI PSHIT? *Father, father*
6. CHAW NASH ASHUKWAASHA. *I don't know*
7. MISH PAM MIYANASHMA IPAPANAMUNXA? *Do all children recognize their relatives?*
8. II, TE'AAXW PIMASHUKSHA. *yes, they know them*
9. NATUTASAAANMI TE'AAXW XITWAYMA APAPANAMUNXA. *my father's relatives all recognize each other*
10. NA'ILAS IWA ANUT'AT. *my mother is an orphan state of being an orphan*
11. AYKSHAASH, LAXS AWA TAXNUTWAY. *she is she - possessive she was the person she was not a relative)*

VERBS: WA, VERB TO BE

SHUK- RECOGNIZE, KNOW,

NAMUN- kin, relation by blood/marriage.

yik- hear, listen, learn

ayk- listen to  
- am told

aykink listen to him/ them

ayk sha-ash I hear

shukwaa- know
