| 5. | íchna tীনma pa-nisháyk-shana. | (here people (they) lived.) people lived here. |
| 6. | íkwna awínshma pa-np'íwixá. | (over there men fished) the men usually fished over there. |
| 7. | ii, íkuni i-wínana natilas. | yes, my (maternal) grandfather went that way. |
