

3. Choose Medium for the Image size.

4. Click on the Create Package button.

A zipped folder will then be downloaded to your computer. Double-click on the zipped icon if it has not already unzipped itself (on a Windows computer, you may need to right-click on the icon and choose to expand the folder and its contents).

Inside the unzipped folder you will find a folder titled "images", which contains all your images from this slideshow in the appropriate size for PowerPoint.

A separate set of instructions explains how to load a folder full of images into PowerPoint.
