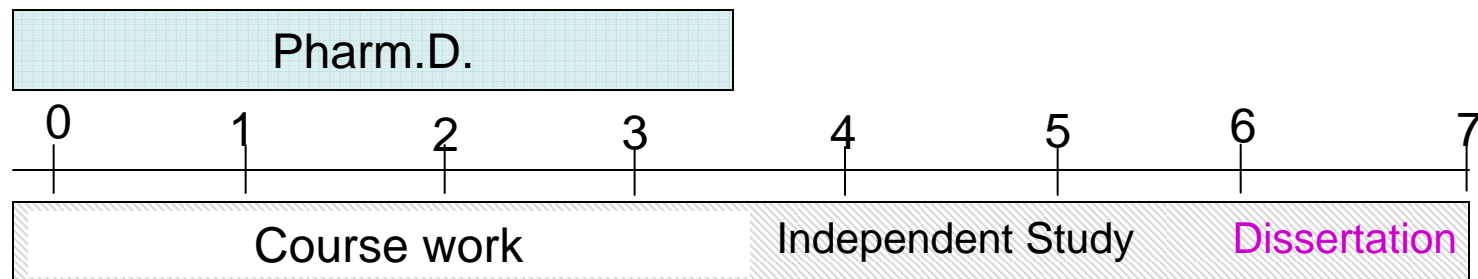


Appendix A

Pharm.D.-Ph.D. proposed time-line



Schematic presentation of a typical student enrolled in the dual degree program. The students who are admitted into dual degree program will begin their study in the summer quarter. Approximately 3.7 years will be allocated to complete the course work, clinical training and internship required for Pharm.D. professional program, while taking course work required by respective Ph.D. program. The students are required to enrolled in the summer quarters throughout to take graduate courses and perform laboratory research. It is anticipated that students will receive Pharm.D. degree by the end of 4 year. From the later part of 4th year, they will focus on graduate research in respective programs—including taking CUM and general exams as well as performing independent study, writing dissertation and passing oral defense—in the School of Pharmacy to complete their Ph.D. training.
