1. Before completing the attached Program/Exchange Application, please consult the applicable program brochure to confirm that the program or exchange is offered during the term(s) you wish to go abroad and that you meet all eligibility criteria.

2. To be considered for a UW program or exchange abroad, you must submit a **complete** application consisting of:
 - Complete UW Program/Exchange Application Form.
 - Two letters of recommendation from **UW faculty or instructors familiar with your academic work**. Recommendations may be sent directly to the Spanish and Portuguese Division or hand-delivered by you. In either case, the letter should arrive in a sealed envelope with the signature of the recommender on the envelope's back seal. Recommendation guidelines are available upon request from the IPE Office.
 - An unofficial and current UW transcript, and unofficial transcripts from all other colleges and universities attended (unless otherwise specified).
 - **Statement of Purpose:** *(Please attach)*
In no more than **two pages, typed and double-spaced**, please write a statement indicating your background and qualifications for study and living abroad, your reasons for choosing this program or exchange, and the projected benefits of this experience to your course of study and long-term plans. Include any other information you feel is relevant to your application.
 - Brief statement in your own words of how you plan to finance your foreign study experience.

- These documents must be submitted together at one time** to the Division of Spanish and Portuguese in care of Jorge González-Casanova, Padelford C-104. Our office hours are 8am-5pm, Monday-Friday. See Application Form for mailing address.
