

Public Outreach Goals



- Educate children and adults about the basic principles of how brain cells work.
- De-stigmatize mental health disorders by informing children and adults about how brain cell dysfunction.
 - Mental health disorders are not due to personal failure but neuron dysfunction
- Promote and represent diversity in science transgender and genderqueer) and encourage the public to embrace their roles as scientists in the world.
 - Everyone can be a scientist.
- Generate accessible science learning materials for a broad audience.
 - Create educational videos and tools for education.
- De-mystify science and highlight the utility of the scientific method in everyday life.
 - We test hypotheses, and never prove them. Rather we reject hypotheses (and come up with a better hypothesis) or fail to reject and keep testing.
