

Minutes for CSS Undergraduate Committee meeting

May 12, 2006

Approved on June 2, 2006

Attending: Josh Tenenberg (secretary), Donald Chinn, Marty Stepp, Larry Crum, Fiona Johnson.

- The minutes of the May 2 meeting were approved.
- The committee agreed that the TQS 311 course that Horak teaches will not satisfy the "Calculus" entry requirement for the CSS major. We will inform the full voting faculty of this decision at this afternoon's faculty/staff meeting.
- Johnson reported that currently, the only Statistics course that we allow students on campus to take to fulfill our Statistics entry requirements is the TBUS 301 course. The committee determined that we will continue to use this policy, including for students who take lower-division courses at UWT. We will recommend at today's faculty/staff meeting that the undergraduate committee return to this issue next year to examine the content of this course more closely to determine how to best meet program needs.
- The committee determined that 1) we will accept on our 142- and 143-equivalency lists all of those courses from CC's that UW Seattle CSE accepts as equivalent to their 142 and 143 (Tenenberg will contact Crystal Eney in order to obtain this equivalency list), and 2) we will ask our CC partners at the May 19 CTC/IT meeting how we should best establish this equivalency in order to ensure that our students are accurately placed.
