

Minutes for CSS Undergraduate Committee meeting

- The minutes from the Oct. 12 meeting were approved as amended. All approved minutes are kept in

- The undergraduate committee recommends (vote: 5-0) to the voting faculty that Endicott-Popovsky's *Information Assurance* course be offered as a TCSS 490 Special Topics course with "TINST 310 or consent of instructor" as prerequisites, for winter, 2006. It was also recommended that the voting faculty resolve whether TCSS majors or graduate students should receive course credit for this course.
- The undergraduate committee recommends (vote: 3-1-1) to the voting faculty the following process for determining which courses outside the Institute can be used to satisfy a breadth course requirement in the Applied Computing minor.

The CSS program will maintain a list of "approved courses" that will satisfy the breadth course requirement. Only those courses listed on the "approved course list" can be counted for the breadth course requirement in the Applied Computing minor. These courses will be recommended by the undergraduate committee to the voting faculty for approval.

- The undergraduate committee recommends (vote: 4-1) to the voting faculty that TACCT 330 be on the "approved course list" for the Applied Computing Minor.
- Lyon-Banks will find out if students can "double dip", i.e. use a required course in their major to satisfy the breadth requirement in the Applied Computing minor.
