The University of Washington Tumor Vaccine Group is studying how the body's immune system fights cancer. We are developing tests to help measure immune response in order to create vaccines and immune therapies for cancer. This is done by studying white blood cells that we collect during **leukapheresis**.

## VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

**Leukapheresis:** 3 - 4 hour procedure in which your blood passes through a machine and a portion (3/4 - 1 cup) of white blood cells are collected.

### Inclusion criteria:

- Cancer survivor
- Not undergoing chemotherapy
- Normal blood counts
- 18 years or older
