Isn't it time that the poorest workers in California have basic fairness? That's why the California legislature overwhelmingly passed SB 1736, to grant farm workers the same right that firemen and policemen already have.

SB 1736 will even the playing field and grant farm workers the dignity fairness and justice that Cesar Chavez gave his life for. Governor Davis, with one stroke of your pen, you can make Cesar Chavez' dream a reality.
