

On-Time Autism Intervention Project:

Questions for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Providers

- 1. What is your approach to including parents or coaching or training parents to support the child at home?
- 2. How do you determine goals and what does parent input look like for that?
- 3. Can parents be involved in therapy sessions? Am I allowed to observe?
- 4. How do you make sure the treatment approach is developmentally appropriate for a child my child's age?
- 5. Can you tell me a little bit about the environments where you teach?
- 6. My child has challenging behaviors, how will you work with him/her to address these issues? Will you support me with these challenges?
- 7. Do you use a more structured approach or a more play-based approach in your intervention?
- 8. What happens if the child you are working with does not make progress with the approach you are using?
- 9. How many children have you worked with who are my child's age?
- 10. How do you accommodate nap schedules? What happens if providers are available during my child's regular nap time?
- 11. For bilingual families: My family is bilingual, have you worked with bilingual families? What is your approach to working with bilingual families?
- 12. What does collaboration with other professionals look like?
