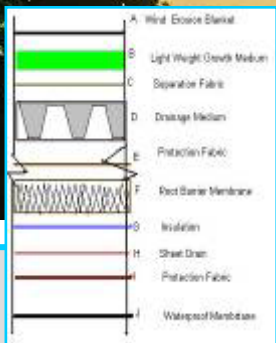
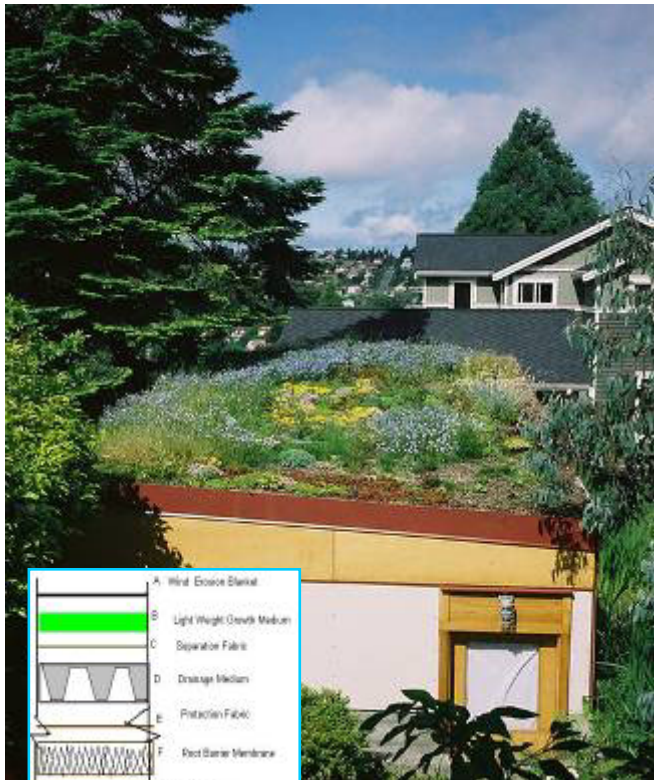




Green Roofs & Cisterns: A Practical Design Workshop

Green building practices are quickly entering the mainstream. In the Pacific Northwest we're seeing a particular focus on strategies that protect our water resources: turning our famous rainfall into an asset, collecting it and slowing its flow; making our built environment function more like the native Northwest forests it replaced.

This workshop is designed to help architects, builders, and engineers of residential and small commercial projects learn how to design and build Green Roofs, and Cisterns for stormwater detention and rainwater reuse. Learn from the practical experience of local experts, through projects around our region.

In the morning, participants will walk through the design and construction process on a variety of green roof examples from our region. We'll explore the materials, techniques, design, permitting, and construction challenges of building green roof systems in the Pacific Northwest.

In the afternoon we'll examine projects around the region that have used cisterns for rainwater harvesting and stormwater detention, and walk through the "how to" of basic engineering, design, materials, operation, and novel construction issues for these systems.
