

Buses/Light Rail are frequent UW – ask google for Red Square, Suzzallo, or Henry Art Gallery.

Closest pt to tower is marked on page 3

**-- Street Parking:**

**Mon-Sat:** Other than 12<sup>th</sup> Av between NE43rd and 41<sup>st</sup> Street (red line), which is unlimited free parking, street parking is usually metered 2hrs max, up to 8pm. Blue lines mark known good parking streets, orange slightly cheaper, see next page for more details.

**Sun:** Street parking is free.

**-- UW Parking:**

\$ marks gatehouses (four).

\$\$ marks gatehouse for under Red Square.

**Weekday** parking is \$15 everywhere

**Evening** (4pm onwards) & **Sat am** parking is \$5 at \$ and \$10 at \$\$\$. (Leave by 7am)

***Non-event Sun, Sat pm and holidays***

all UW parking (\$\$ incl) is free.

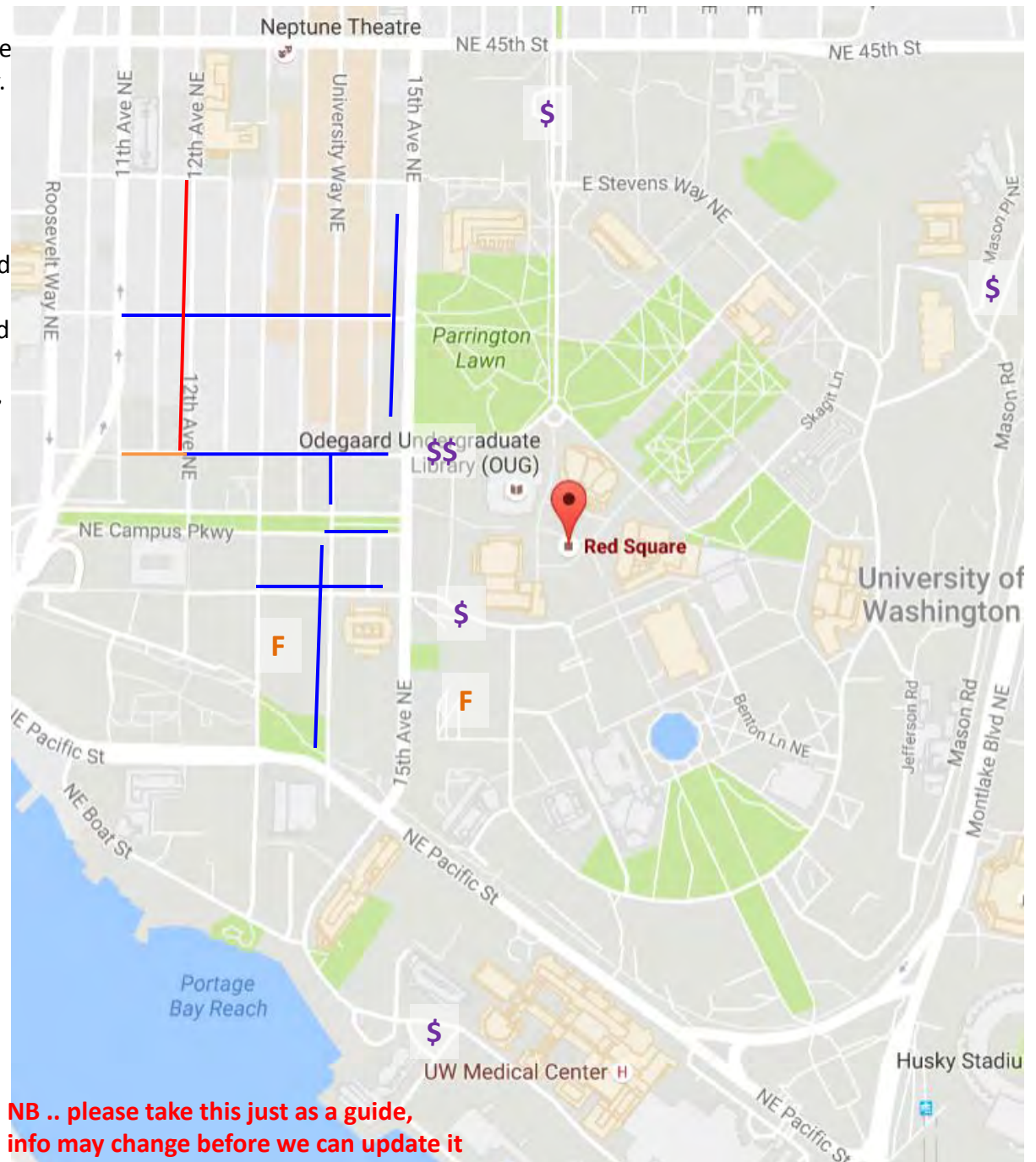
**Event weekends**, at \$ & \$\$, still more costly.

Try pleading for usual rate, as not for event.

**Event weekends after 12pm**, parking in non-central UW lots (e.g., 2 examples, marked F should be free) unless signed.

**-- Summary of parking advice:**

- weekday evenings – street parking
- Sat am only – street or pay at \$
- Sat all day, event all day – pay at \$, or street and move car half way.
- Sat pm and Sun (non event)– free at \$\$

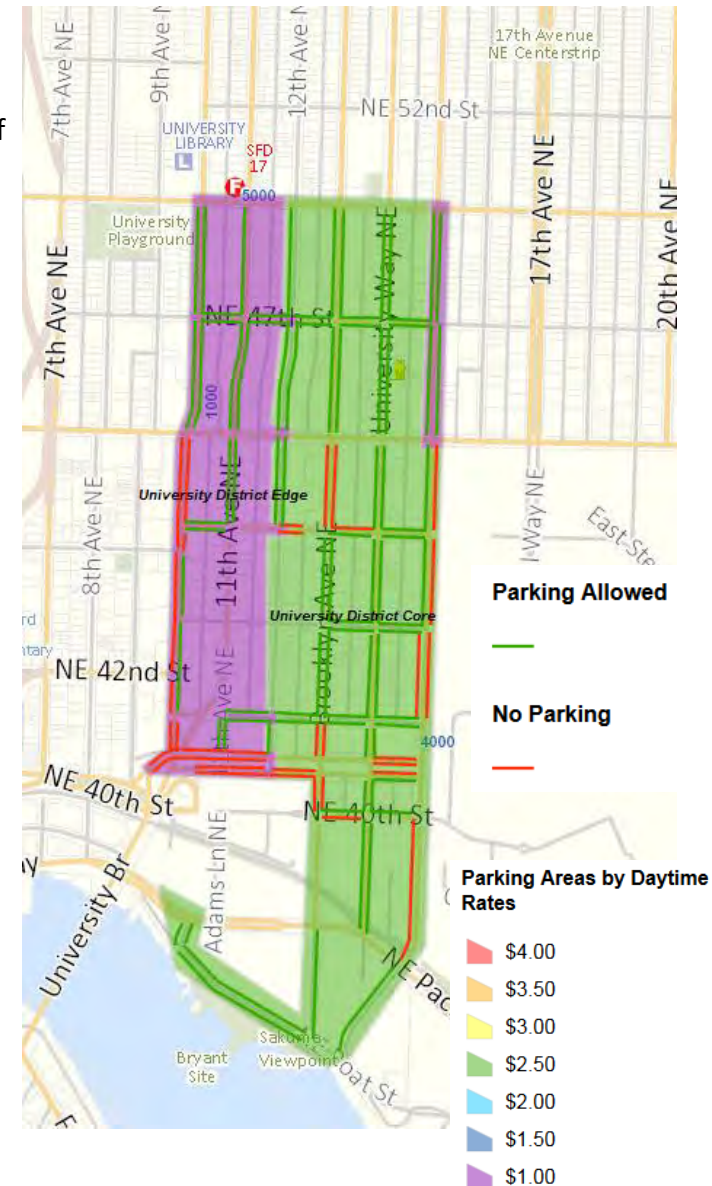

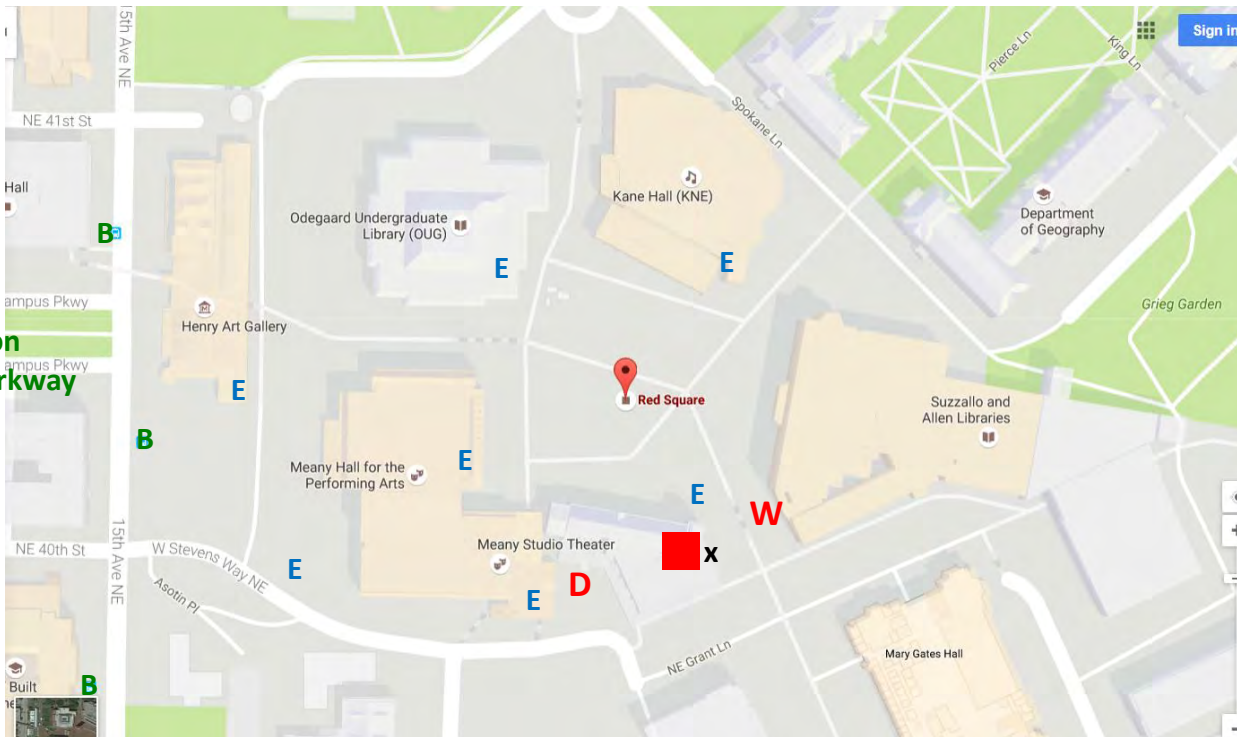
