Call for Proposals

Certificate in Public Scholarship Course Development Grants: 2012-2014

What: Course development grants of \$500-2500 for graduate courses (and credit-bearing opportunities) allied with the objectives and goals of the Certificate in Public Scholarship. These funds can be used to develop or redevelop a course in collaboration with community partners and/or faculty members/staff members/graduate students; to pilot a new HUM 595 micro-seminar; or to run and supervise a collaborative directed research project for which graduate students receive independent study credit, among other options. Courses should be scheduled for 2012-13 or 2013-14.

Funds can be used for community partner/collaborator stipends, faculty stipends, graduate student stipends, or course/project expenses (e.g. curricular materials, site rental, transportation costs).

Who: CPS advisors, steering committee members, and affiliated faculty have priority in consideration for funding. A curriculum committee (a subcommittee of the steering committee) will review applications.

Why: To promote more opportunities for CPS faculty and students to engage in cross-sectoral, co-curricular collaborations with each other and with partner organizations; to actualize curricular engagements with multiple audiences.

How: Submit a short proposal (1-2 pages) that includes a brief description of the course, including when it will be taught and for how many credits, and the plan for its (re)development, including a budget that outlines how funds will be allocated. Include a brief statement on how the course will support CPS learning objectives and/or program goals (outlined at www.simpsoncenter.org/certificate-public-scholarship.)

Faculty who receive course development grants will be asked to report back to the program directors and steering committee in a short document or presentation.

When: Proposals received by June 1, 2012 will receive first consideration in the June 8 review. Please send proposals to Miriam Bartha at mbartha@uw.edu. Proposals will thereafter be considered on a rolling basis, as funds are available.
